Regulation Summary

Academic institutions of The Texas A&M University System (system) authorized to confer degrees must include specific components on diplomas in accordance with this regulation to ensure uniformity.

Regulation

1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- 1.1 Each chief executive officer (CEO) of a system academic institution authorized to confer degrees has the responsibility for assuring all diplomas offered by that member include:
 - (a) the seal or diploma seal of the member;
 - (b) the name of the graduate receiving the degree;
 - (c) the degree conferred;
 - (d) the date the degree conferred;
 - (e) the name of the member; and
 - (f) signatures of the chairman of the Board of Regents, the chancellor of the system and the president/CEO of the member.
- 1.2 Other signatures, seals, wording, etc., may appear on the diploma at the discretion of the member CEO.

Member Rule Requirements

A rule is not required to supplement this regulation.
