### **Policy Statement**

This policy allows each chief executive officer (CEO) of The Texas A&M University System (system) members to allocate a portion of the funds for a construction project for the acquisition of art.

---

### **Reason for Policy**

This policy authorizes each system member to allocate up to 1% of the construction cost for the acquisition of art.

---

### **Procedures and Responsibilities**

It is the intention of the system Board of Regents that a maximum of one percent (1%) of the estimated original cost of each new building construction project exceeding \$1,000,000 may be allocated for the acquisition of works of art and other aesthetic improvements. The works of art shall be located at or near the site of the construction project. The acquisition of the works of art shall be in accordance with the system member's art acquisition standards and shall be approved by the system member CEO. The appropriation and expenditure of funds shall be made on a case-by-case basis by the system member and shall be in accordance with the applicable system policies and regulations.
