

**60.01.02 Association with Affiliated Support Organizations**

*March 11, 2004*

***Supplements System Policy 60.01***

1. GENERAL

State and federal statutes guide each component of The Texas A&M University System in establishing a relationship with an affiliated organization. For purposes of this regulation, an affiliated organization is a private donor or organization designed to support the purposes of a System component. System Regulation *60.01.01, Association with Affiliated Fund Raising Organizations*, guides the association between a component and an affiliated organization that ***is primarily a fund raising organization.***

2. REQUIREMENTS

Each System component must follow the rules below, which govern the conduct of the component and its employees in a relationship with an affiliated organization.

- 2.1 The affiliated organization may not use component employees except as negotiated in a written agreement with the component.
  - 2.2 The affiliated organization may not use component property except as negotiated in a written agreement with the component.
  - 2.3 An affiliated organization may not provide direct monetary enrichment to a component employee (salary or benefits).
  - 2.4 No member of management or other employee that has a direct role in the management of the component may serve on the organization's board except as an ex-officio member appointed by the CEO. The organization's board shall be responsible for the administration and investment of funds received by the organization for the benefit of the component.
3. An affiliated organization must have the written permission of the component CEO or designee to use the name, logos, trademarks, seals, service marks or other identifying marks of the component as stated in System Policy *09.02, Use of System Names and Indicia.*
